



## Charitable Donation Guidelines

End Childhood Hunger was organized to provide direct support, material resources, organizational development, services and information to help end childhood hunger, with a particular focus on nutrition education, food assistance, community activism, development of food resources and programs and promotion of Federal, State and local nutrition entitlement programs. We support emerging, niche, and grassroots hunger organizations that directly impact the issue of childhood hunger in South Florida.

### Applicants must meet the following criteria to apply:

1. The application must fall within the the Foundations general grant philosophy as indicated above.
2. Must possess Tax exempt status under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
3. Must not discriminate on basis of race, color, sex, sexual orientation, religion, political affiliation, nationality, disability, age or marital status.

### End Childhood Hunger does not fund:

1. Gifts to individuals or third-parties raising funds on behalf of charities.
2. Organizations not eligible for non-exempt support.
3. Sectarian or religious programs.
4. Conferences or Exhibits.
5. Advertising.
6. Political or campaign groups.
7. Any activity that would be in conflict with compliance with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") .
